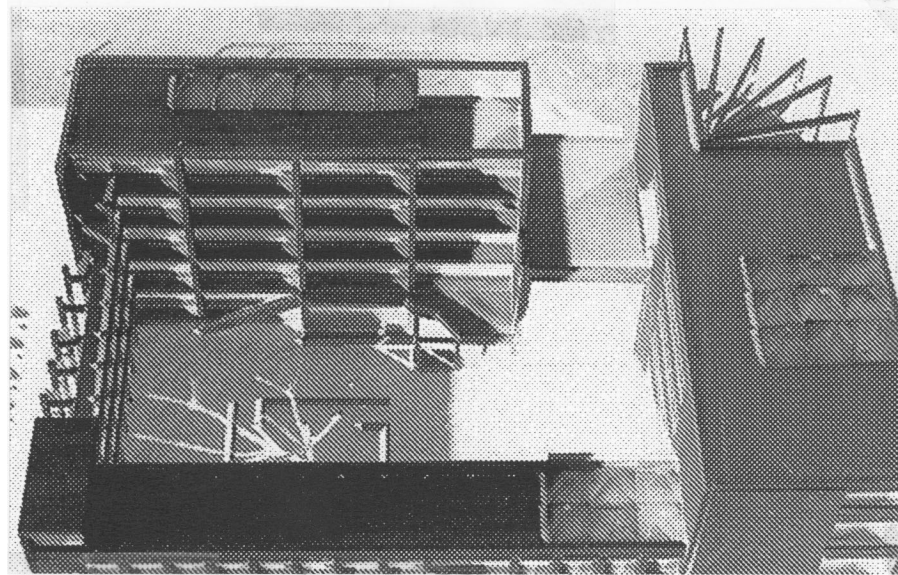
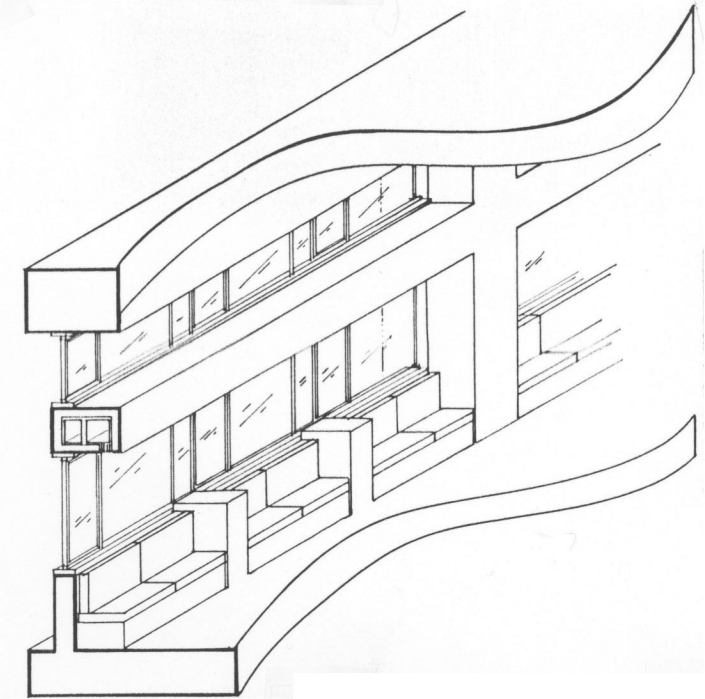


Classroom building

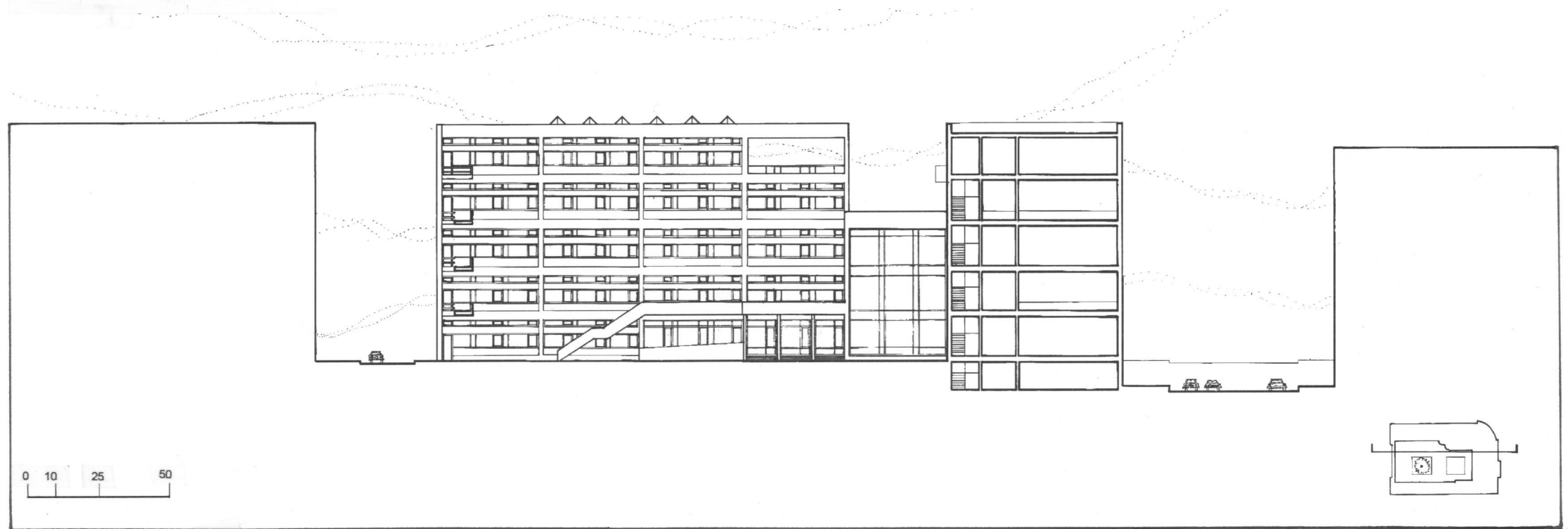
The classroom building houses the classrooms on upper floors and a cafeteria area on the lower floors. There are connections to the courtyard space through balconies and window views. The cafeteria has bar type seats facing the courtyard. The second floor has a balcony from which people can access the courtyard. At the fifth floor one bay has been opened up to form a loggia which serves as a connection between the internal campus and the city. The halls outside of the classrooms have benches built under the windows. The benches provide areas for unplanned exchanges of greetings and ideas.
